

## Best Practices for Green Events Organizers



**Great Lakes Green Events** organizers proactively reduce the environmental impact of their event and financially support tree planting projects. Organizers may implement some or all of the best practices listed below:

## Reduce

- Provide water refill stations
- Use digital signage and/or biodegradable printed materials
- Replace printed agendas or materials with digital materials, event webpages, or apps
- · Compost food waste
- Donate unserved food to local organizations
- Work with the event space to eliminate excessive heating or cooling
- Buy local foods when possible
- Select walkable off-site event spaces or provide group transportation
- Communicate with transportation providers to reduce idling and unnecessary trips

## Reuse

- Collect badges and lanyards at the end of the event
- Provide reusable silverware
- Purchase eco-friendly swag items

## Recycle, Upcycle, or Donate

• Recycle materials where possible and donate meeting decorations to other events
