The Project: Green Bond Funds used for three capital projects:

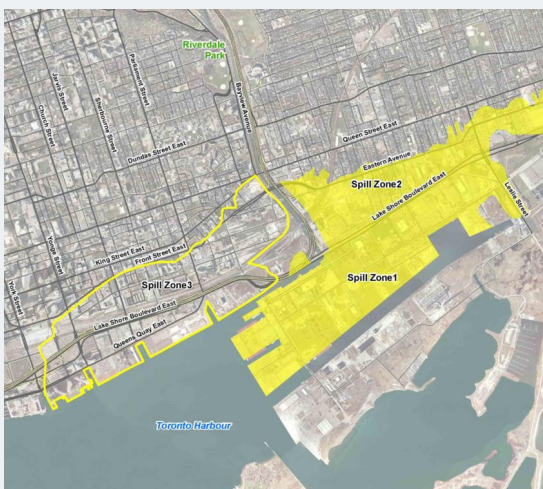
1. Port Lands Flood Protection - one of the largest infrastructure projects in Toronto's history, it will protect Toronto's southeastern downtown area from extreme flooding by creating a naturalized river mouth that reconnects the Don River to Lake Ontario.
2. Toronto Community Housing Corporation (TCHC) - building retrofits for energy efficiency
3. Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) - track replacement and repair for public transit subway and Light Rail Transit (LRT)

- Protection and restoration of streams and wetlands
- Flood management
- Energy Saved
